What is the 45th edition of the *Québec Games* ?

From July 29 to August 6, 2010, Gatineau will host the 45th edition of the *Québec Games*, the most noted sports gathering in Québec. During this event, Gatineau will welcome some 4,000 young athletes, 800 accompanying adults and thousands of tourists from all over the province.

Facts about the 45th edition of the *Québec Games* – Gatineau 2010 :

- **19** regions represented
- **17** sports in competition
- **4** sports for athletes with mobility disabilities
- **4000** athletes
- **3500** volunteers
- **400** officials
- **800** accompanying adults
- **20 000** tourists in Gatineau
- **\$6 to 8 millions** economic impact

Nursery of Olympic talent !

Under *SPORTSQUÉBEC* umbrella
(a non-profit organization) representing :

✚ **64** sport federations

✚ **19** regions

✚ The first edition of the Québec Games was held in August 1971



✚ Starting in 2009, Winter and Summer Games will alternate
(Even years = Summer, Uneven = Winter)

✚ More than **3 million athletes** have participated since the Games inception in 1971!

✚ Over the last 38 years Québec Games have generated a \$380 millions economic impact !

Here are some facts about the *Québec Games* of Winter 2007, compared to Turin olympic games (Winter 2006) :

Number of events (Summer & Winter)	45	43
Participating Athletes	Turin – Winter 2006 2508	3000
Coaches and Trainers	Turin – 2006 180	800
Sports (winter)	15	16
Number of Competitions	Turin – 2006 84	Winter 2007 100
